FITTING PROCEDURE



1. Remove O.E stone shields and retain ALL mounting bolts for later use.



2. Fit front mounting bracket to cross-member using M8 x 35 bolts, spring washers and flat washers. Fit 2 x M8 cage nuts in square holes on top surface of mount. When fitting transmission lines be sure they clear any sharp edges.

3. Fit 3 x M8 cage nuts to rear of panel. Lift front panel into position and secure using original M10 bolts in middle and 2 x M8 x 35 bolts, spring washers and flat washers on front mount. Leave finger tight.




4. Lift sump panel assembly into place and attach to cross member using original M10 bolts. Secure to front panel using 3 x M8 x 35 bolts, spring washers and flat washers. Leave all bolts finger tight. Once this is done insert 1 x M8 cage nut at the centre position at rear of panel.

FITTING PROCEDURE



5. Fit mounting plate as shown using original bolts.



6. Lift transmission panel into place and secure to mounting plate using 2 x M8 bolts, spring washers, flat washers and flange nuts. Secure to sump panel using 3 x M8 x 35 bolts, spring washers, flat washers and 2 x M8 flange nuts. Note that the flange nuts go to the outside positions as the centre uses a cage nut. Leave bolts finger tight.



7. Fit transfer case panel using original M10 bolt with large washer removed in vehicle torsion bar mount and 2 x M8 bolts, spring washers, flat washers and flange nuts into transmission panel. Once all this is done tighten all bolts.
